- Annual PAVOAD meeting will be held on Sept 27, 2026
- Fourth of July weekend storms updates
 - Blair County
 - Crisis Relief and Recover has done damage assessments especially in Tyrone
 - Carpet, flooring, cabinets, HVAC, water heaters
 - Mucking and gutting phase
 - Debris removal
 - Community volunteer day tomorrow, Saturday July 11
 - Local groups?
 - No COAD; falls under central VOAD region
 - Christine has a pre-COAD list and will talk to organizations at the MARC on Tuesday
 - UCC is looking for leadership locally
 - MARC on Tues, July 14 2-6 pm at Church of the Good Shepherd
 - Monroe County
 - Wind damage
 - People with disabilities/ mobility issues had trouble evacuating
 - Southern Baptists, Team Rubicon, and UCC present
 - Homes where insurance will not pay to remove trees
 - Middle Smithfield and Smithfield townships were hit the hardest
 - 99.5% of home electric restored
 - Lancaster County
 - Jenifer Jarvis – Lancaster Snow Angels
 - Trees and wires still down
 - Cannot access some homes that have requested help
 - Have been assisting survivors without insurance
 - Issues and delays because insurance adjusters want to do assessments before any work is completed
 - Lack trailers to help with tree removal
 - Where can they take waste?
 - PPL almost all residential power restored as of this morning
 - Crisis Relief and Recovery
 - Health and safety come first

- Take lots of photos
 - Never had someone say they are not covered because they went ahead with muck and gut
 - Waste and debris contracts slow to come – can be months like Hurricane Debby
 - Have donors and sponsors to pay for dump trailers
 - Taking it to curb show municipality there is a problem
 - PEMA – Brooke can do reach out to municipalities
- York County
 - Manchester and Fairview townships
 - County has completed assessments
 - Wait and see – no unmet needs met
 - Fallout after insurance claims
- Armstrong County
 - Crisis track – damage assessment tracker for the entire state
- Beaver County
 - Back-to-back flooding
 - DRAP one time grant up to \$20,000
 - Need a SBA declaration to initiate
 - 25% 40% uninsured loss
 - Evaluation next week
 - Photos needed
 - Coordinating Response
 - Team Rubicon
 - Latter Day Saints
 - Cleanup cohort – wait until after MARC in Blair County
- Tioga County
 - TSA – water and cleanup kits in Tioga County (6-8 houses)
- Oak Forest Apartment Fire
 - DRAP activation
 - UCC presence
 - DLOC event
 - SBA – Lane Davis
 - Low interest disaster recovery loans to survivors
 - DLOC will close next Thursday, hours 8am-4pm good attendance
 - WFMZ did a piece
